

New program rewards top prep scholars

The University has chosen 47 of Oregon's most outstanding high school graduates to each receive \$1,000 Presidential Scholarships to study here this fall.

University Pres. Paul Olum announced the names at his regular monthly press conference Friday.

"These scholarships, renewable for up to four years, are intended to attract the state's top graduates to the quality educational programs in the sciences, liberal arts and professions available at the University of Oregon," Olum said. "They are one of several reasons why top students should be giving this University their highest consideration when choosing a college."

The University expects to award 50 Presidential Scholarships for 1983-84, and eventually plans to award 200 scholarships a year. The final three recipients have yet to be selected.

More than one-fourth of the scholars have straight-A grade

point averages, and all exceed the 3.75 minimum GPA. In addition, each person has demonstrated leadership in extracurricular activities and community service.

Scholarship money comes from private and group or

foundation donations to the University Foundation.

The Earle Chiles Foundation of Portland recently donated \$37,000 for business student scholarships, said Russell Picton, executive director of the University Foundation.

That gift brings the total amount raised for the scholarships to \$91,000.

Scholarship recipients come from high schools throughout Oregon. The recipients have declared majors in most of the University's undergraduate degree programs, and about one-third of the students have declared science-related majors.

The scholarship committee based their selections on each student's achievements, a personal statement of educa-

tional and career goals, and recommendations. More than 625 students received nominations from 129 high schools throughout the state.

Chancellor Bud Davis said he is "delighted by the outstanding effort made by the University of Oregon in its

Presidential Scholarship program." Davis announced the program as part of the Campaign for Excellence unveiled earlier this year.

"As a result of hard work by Pres. Olum and the active involvement of University facul-

ty in the recruitment of these outstanding students, the University has attracted an excellent group of scholars," Davis said.
