'Rithmetic conference is slated

A conference for educators interested in upgrading math teaching in the third through 12th grades will be offered Aug. 15-26 at the University.

The College of Education and the Continuation Center designed the conference in response to a recent national

study that reported Scholastic Aptitude Test math scores dropped significantly from 1963 to 1983.

"The conference is for educators in every subject area, not just in math," said Teresa Barker, conference coordinator. "Participants will get hands-on experience in

LOGO language and computer workshops, and they will learn how to improve their classroom teaching skills."

Participants will also be taught how to create classroom environments that foster higher-order thinking skills in mathematics, such as problem solving strategies, as well as learn various approaches to developing computational skills.

Math consultant Joan Akers will deliver the first-week keynote speech. Eugene Maier, director of the Math Learning Center in Salem, will deliver the keynote address the second week.

Other conference speakers and staff include Rick Billstein, math professor at the University of Montana; Dick Brannan, a Eugene math consultant; and University math education instructors Ruth Parker and Oscar Schaaf.
