# University student wins Truman scholarship

University student Carol Benedick has been selected as Oregon's recipient of the 1984 Harry Truman Scholarship. Benedick, a junior in international studies, was one of only 105 students chosen this year.

"It's a very high honor — very similar to the Rhodes," says Clarence Thurber, director of the international studies department. In order to be eligible for this scholarship students must be no more than halfway through their sophomore year when applying and must be entering their junior year at the time of the award's receival, Thurber says.

The awards, which offer up to \$5,000 per year for the last two years of college and two years of graduate study, are granted to highly motivated students who are pursuing careers in public service at the federal, state or local level.
