There will be 700-plus athletes competing at Hayward Field Monday through Saturday — and only 51 will take home gold medals. Tuesday is the final day of the decathlon and heptathlon, and qualifying trials in a variety of track and field events begin on Wednesday. Finals don't begin until Friday afternoon and the last event — the men's mile relay — will start Saturday at 5:10 p.m.
