One of Eugene's finer restaurants, the Excelsior Cafe is a great place to take that special friend. The decor is brick, marble and oak with a European flare. The atmosphere is casual and relaxed, catering to community members, professors and students.

Offering 17 different bottled beers, this establishment features one drink, the "Golden" Section," only to be found at the Excelsior. Concocted by a certain group of University architecture students, the drink is a warmed blend of rum, amaretto, kahlua, creme de cacao, coffee and whipped cream served in a tall glass with a hint of lemon juice. Allowed to stand, The Golden Section separates into layers, making a colorful and exotic drink.

Vet's Club, 1626 Willamette

The Vet's Club was established in 1948, and in the past 36 years has become a

Eugene landmark. Serving the strongest and lowest-priced mixed drinks in town (including a kamakazi mix that's almost toxic), the Vet's Club also has a full kitchen, a dance floor and live music on weekends.


