


Home-designed T-shirts offer cheap individuality and a chance to exercise your creativity.

When you have all your materials and have pre-washed the shirt, you're ready to begin. It's a good idea to protect the floor with old Emeralds or other newspapers. 
Let your left brain take over and see what happens. When your masterpiece is completely dry (overnight is best), iron it with a hot iron from the back side of the shirt to permanently set the paint. From then on, the T-shirt can be washed normally.
