U.S. Sen. Gary Hart, D-Colo., will speak at the University Wednesday at 2:30 p.m. in the EMU Ballroom — rain or shine. Mondale/Ferraro officials announced Saturday.

The former candidate for the Democratic presidential nomination will be stopping in Eugene during a one-day trip to Oregon to gather support for the Democratic ticket. Hart will attend a luncheon in Portland shortly before noon and will talk there at 12:20. Tickets for the luncheon are still available

Democratic presidential candidate Walter Mondale also will be in Portland early Monday morning for a brief speech at Portland State University.

### EMU Budget Committee

The EMU Budget Committee elected Ahrea Summers, a student-at-large representative to the board, as subcommittee chair at its first meeting Tuesday afternoon.

The nine-member committee adjourned after a brief discussion on the group's functions and procedures. The next meeting will be held Nov. 8 at 4 p.m. in Room 337 EMU and is open to the public.

### EMU House Committee

The committee discussed the possibility of changing or removing the William Jones' "statement of purpose" sign, which was the focus of controversy last year. Various students, including former ASUO President Mary Hotchkiss, questioned the sign's use of the word "men" in reference to people. The committee will review the issue before taking it before the board and ultimately before the student body.

Four student groups requested EMU desk or office space at the meeting, including the College Democrats, the Latin American Support Committee, Catalyst and the Gay and Lesbian Alliance.

Eligibility factors such as need, the group's service to the University, number of members, maintenance of office hours, and past use or misuse of office space will be taken into consideration by the board before allocations are arranged.
