The Oregon Student Lobby is sponsoring a legislative workshop Saturday from 9 a.m. to noon in Hearing Room C of the State Capitol.

The workshop will feature presentations on the legislative process and lobbying techniques, as well as discussions on the sales tax, other revenue issues and funding of higher education.

"This workshop will be an opportunity for students to learn about the legislative process and learn how to get involved and have an impact on issues

The party includes music by the Cashiers and Single Mary, videos relating to topical political issues and letter-writing with the aid of word processors. There will also be a political trivia contest with prizes donated by the sponsoring organizations and a special appearance by Eugene's own Out 2 Lunch comedy group.

"We want people to leave feeling good about dancing to some great bands, and also having a concrete impact on the political process through writing at least one letter," says Sherri Schultz, one of the party's organizers.

The event starts at 8 p.m. with a

showing of the recent "Concert for Peace" video in Managua, Nicaragua. The Cashiers will follow; Single Mary will play at 9:45 p.m.

Admission is \$2.50 before 9 p.m., \$3 afterward. A special admission price of \$2 will be given to those with a ticket stub from "State of Siege," a benefit film for the Central American Newsgroup showing at 7 p.m. in 177 Lawrence Hall. All ages are welcome.
