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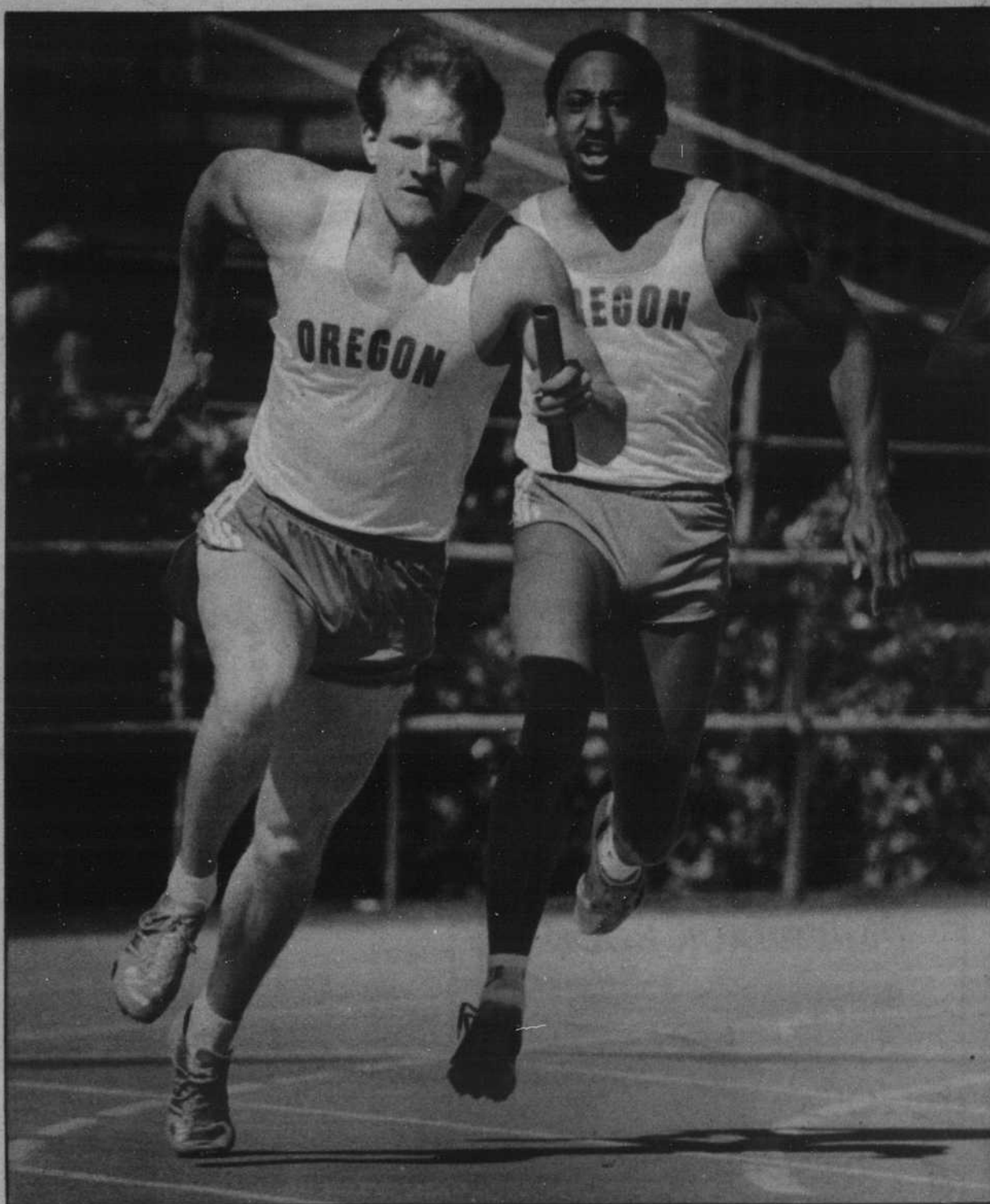

Frazier was held out of the 200 but teammate Jeff Hoskins (21.9) took second behind Howell, who also won the 100. In the 4x100 relay, Oregon was disqualified for the second week in a row. The Ducks missed the second pass between Frazier and Chris Wright.

Wright also finished second in the 400-meters with a 48.2.

In the special 1,500-meter race held after the dual meet, Olympic gold medalist Joaquim Cruz withstood a small rally by Kevin Ryan to win in 3:41.2.

Cruz, who is running in the

international circuit this year, said that he had been working out very slowly.

"This time today gives me a good idea about what shape I am in now, and that means I don't have to change my workout," said Cruz, who will run two more races later in the year.
