All three salsas are packaged in similar plastic containers and range in price from \$1.69 to \$2.39.

Some may like it hot, but for those who don't, Salsa De Casa also comes in mild, either with or without salt. Jan's Salsa is made mild, medium or hot and Miller offers customers four choices: mild, medium, hot or "Caution, Extra Hot" (written on a hot pink label!) The "temperature" of the sauce is determined by varying amounts of peppers, chiles or spices.

All three manufacturers

seem to agree that although the competition between them is fierce, it has also been healthy.

"There's enough business in Eugene for everybody," Paxton says. "We gave people a choice."

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
