On the track, Jeff Hoskins won the 100-meters in the absence of John Frazier, whose whereabouts are unknown. Frazier has been missing from practice since last Monday. Chris Wright captured two victories with wins in the 200- and 400-meters, while the Ducks also swept the 110-meter high

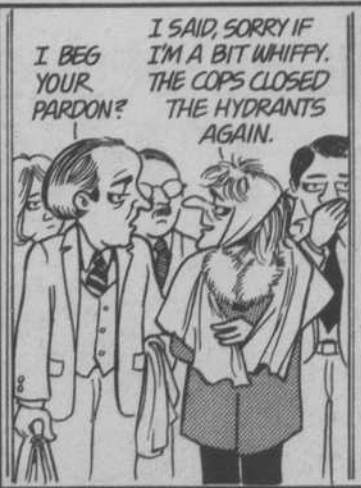
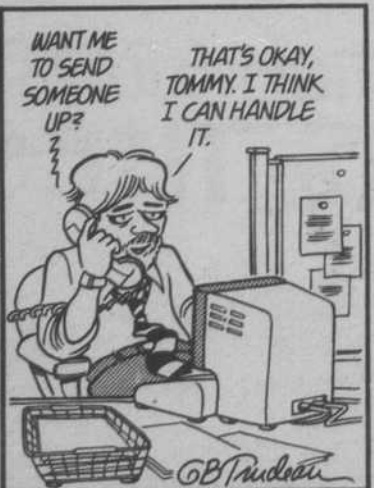
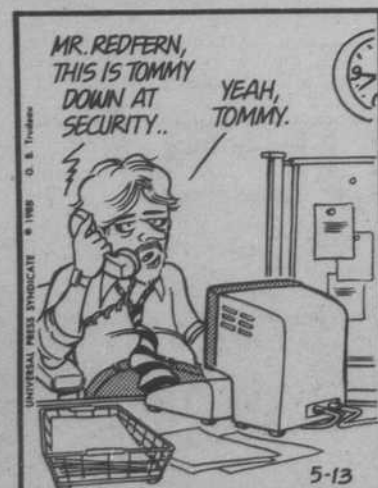
