Shultz letter states Hussein wish to talk

JERUSALEM (AP) — Prime Minister Shimon Peres brought his Cabinet a message Sunday from U.S. Secretary of State George Shultz in which Shultz said he believed Jordan was willing to open direct talks with Israel, government sources said.

Shultz' letter said Jordan's King Hussein affirmed that he intended to work toward Middle East peace talks this year, and that it was Shultz' impression that Jordan favored direct talks based on two United Na-

tions resolutions, said the sources who were unidentified.

U.N. resolutions 242 and 338 call on Israel to give back land captured in the 1967 Arab-Israeli "Six Day War," including the West Bank, Gaza Strip and Golan Heights. They also call for Arab recognition of Israel's right to exist.

Hussein met President Ronald Reagan and other top U.S. government officials in Washington last week.

U.S.-China ties discussed

WASHINGTON (AP) — China's new ambassador to the United States, Han Xu, says relations are good between the two countries, but he warned the Reagan administration that continued arms sales to Taiwan threaten ties to Peking.

In an interview with the Associated Press, Han also cited the stalled U.S.-China nuclear agreement, trade issues and the U.S. political relationship with Taiwan as problems between the two countries. He is Peking's third ambassador since full diplomatic relations were established in 1979.

Han's arrival in Washington, replacing the popular Zhang Wenjin, comes against the background of mounting friction in the U.S.-Chinese relationship.

"If there is any serious thing happening on the Taiwan issue it may cause a setback in our relations," he said. "For instance, if the United States is going to sell advanced arms to Taiwan it would be a clear violation" of an August 1982 joint communique calling for a gradual reduction in the quantity of arms and a freeze on quality.

Socialists win in Greece

ATHENS, Greece (AP) — Premier Andreas Papandreu's Socialist Party claimed a clear-cut victory in Sunday's national elections and a mandate for its platform of building a welfare state while loosening ties with the West.

"This was a crucial election — it was a judgment on four years of the government of change and I think it was a triumph," Papandreu told reporters at his home in a northern suburb of Athens.

Papandreu claimed victory midway through the vote count.

With returns in from 7,644 of 14,738 polling stations, the Socialists had captured 46.5 percent of the vote to 40.2 percent for the conservative New Democracy Party, 10 percent for the Moscow-line Communist Party and 1.8 percent for the small Eurocommunist Party.

According to computer projections, those returns would give the Socialists a majority in the 300-member single-chamber Parliament with 161 seats to 126 for New Democracy, 12 for the Communist Party and one for the Eurocommunists.



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
