NEEDED SUBJECTS: of college age or older, for decision experiment in Political Science and Psychology. Sponsored by the Political Science Department of the University of Oregon. The experiments, which will last between 1 hour and an hour and a half, will be held on the University or Oregon campus. Subjects' payment is dependant on the group outcome of individual decisions of participants. In every experiment there will be subjects whose pay can vary from \$0 to \$8. There will be other subjects whose pay can vary from \$4 to \$6, \$4 to \$8, \$4 to \$20 or \$4 to \$64 depending on the experiment subjects get assigned to. Assignment will be by lottery. Apart from this variable pay, everyone who is confirmed for participation and shows up at the appropriate time is paid \$3 at the end of the experiment, so for some participants the final pay can vary between \$3 and \$11, and for others between \$7 to \$9, \$7 to \$11, \$7 to \$23, or \$7 to \$67.
