Blazers reign over Kings following earlier set backs

PORTLAND(AP) — Portland's Kiki Vandeweghe scored 26 points to lead the balanced Trail Blazers to a 126-115 National Basketball Association victory over the Sacramento Kings Tuesday at Memorial Coliseum.

Six Trail Blazers scored in double figures as Portland shook off a cold first half with a big third quarter.

Larry Drew and Eddie Johnson led Sacramento with 26 points apiece. Clyde Drexler scored 25 points for the Blazers, while 7-foot center Sam Bowie had 18 and shared rebounding honors with Kenny Carr at 11 each. LaSalle Thompson had a game-high 14 rebounds for Sacramento.

Portland hit 16 out of 17 free throws in the fourth quarter after struggling

early in the game. The Blazers shot only 36 percent from the floor in the first quarter which ended with the Kings leading 24-22.

The Kings built their lead at halftime to 55-50 as Portland continued to shoot poorly. The Blazers caught fire with a 40-point third quarter, shooting 64 percent from the floor.

Sacramento scored only 22 in that quarter.

In the fourth quarter, Portland stayed off the Kings' final rush with its 16-for-17 performance at the free throw line.

Portland is now 8-2 in the Pacific Division, while Sacramento fell to 2-6.

Luiz de Oliveira, a coach for the Athletics West track team, says he has been fired by Nike Inc., owner of the club.

De Oliveira coached world-class runners Mary Slaney and Joaquim Cruz, both members of the Eugene-based team.

Ian Campbell, director of athletics for Nike, said the Beaverton sports shoe company and de Oliveira failed to come to terms on a new contract. The coach said he considered himself fired.

De Oliveira, 36, a Brazilian native who began working for Nike in 1981, said he was paid \$35,000 annually in a contract that expired last July. He said he wanted a \$5,000 raise plus incentive bonuses should his athletes win future Olympic or World Championship gold medals or set world records at Olympic distances.

Campbell said de Oliveira's position will not be replaced but that the jobs of the three other Athletics West coaches, Bob Sevens and Andrej and Ella Krzenski, are secure "at this point."

Former players of the Portland Breakers should share some of the blame for the team's demise in the United

States Football League, team owner Joe Canizaro said Monday.

Canizaro said the club, which has neither players nor coaches, will not pay a total debt of \$5 million until its assets are realized.

The Breakers, who finished 6-12 last spring, owe their former players about \$1.4 million for the final four games of the 1985 USFL season.

The USFL Players Association has filed a lawsuit against the Breakers and the league for the back pay.

The Portland team granted its players free agency after the season and reached a contract settlement with its coaches. The Denver Gold franchise is expected to replace the Breakers in Portland next fall.

"I read in the newspaper where (the players) are disappointed with the way I handled things," the businessman told the The Oregonian newspaper. "I'm a little disappointed in the way the club performed. . . I put a lot of money in that football team to try to assure them of the talent and the people necessary to accomplish the job," Canizaro added.



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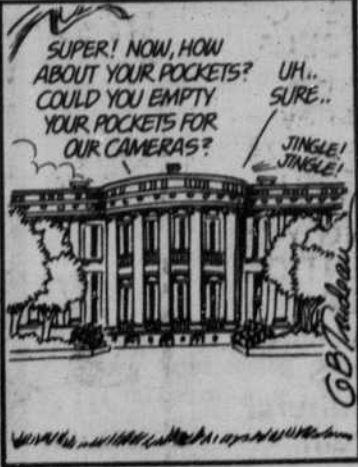
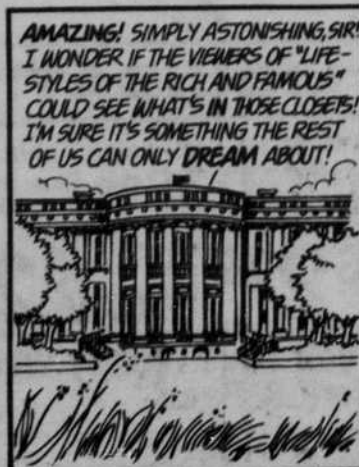
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
