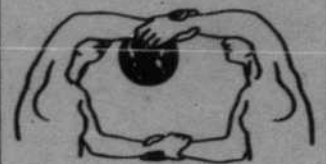

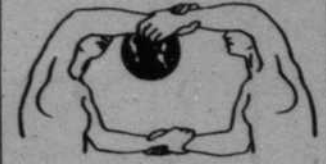


### TAKE BACK THE NIGHT Rally and March
