Golfers lead own tourney

The Oregon golf team flexed its muscle Monday by placing six golfers in the top 11 to open a commanding 15-stroke lead after 27 holes in the Pacific Northwest Intercollegiate at the Eugene Country Club.

Oregon stretched a seven-stroke advantage after 18 holes to the 15-stroke budge after 27 holes over the Oregon State University A squad on the par-72 ECC course. The Ducks shot 542 for 27 holes and are 22 in front of Washington who came in with a 564 to stand third overall.

Portland, Portland State, and the Oregon State B squad rounded out the tourney.

Duck senior George Daves had a three-under 32 on the front nine of the E.C.C. course to go along with an opening-round 74. Daves stands two shots in front of teammate Tim Scott and Oregon State's Brad Leiken who both came in at one-over 108.

"I thought I hit the ball real well," Daves said. "I didn't get a lot of putts to drop or I might have had a little better score on the first 18."

Oregon's Steve Rintoul and Tony Joyner both carded 109's to tie for fourth after 27 holes. Oregon amateur champion Tim Hval is at 110 for sixth in the individual race and sophomore Croy Cochran is in a tie for seventh at 111 to round out the Oregon leaders.

"I didn't make the best of my opportunities," Rintoul said. "You've got to make putts to have an impact, and I didn't make enough of them."

Oregon coach Scott Krieger was pleased with his team's effort.

"We played well and with some consistency that we needed at this point in the season. I just hope for the same type of scores tomorrow," said Krieger after Monday's play. "The most pleasant surprise was Tim Hval who seems to be back on track after struggling a little this fall."

The tournament concludes with 27 holes at Emerald Valley Golf Course in Creswell on Tuesday.
