# Should ROTC be eliminated? Students offer differing views

The controversial ROTC program is again under attack by University professors and students.

Professor Bayard McConaughy recently proposed to the University Senate, for the 14th time in the past 19 years, that the 39-year-old ROTC program be eliminated from campus. He charged that it is an outside agency and that it reinforces militarism.

ROTC trains students to become officers through military science courses and exercises held on campus. After graduation, the students must serve in the Armed Forces.

Campus-area students were asked whether or not ROTC should remain on campus. Some supported the program, and others did not.

"I believe it should be moved off campus simply because it is not an academic group. It's militaristic and doesn't have a place here on campus," said Angela Sondenaa, a sophomore biology major.

Joel Diegleman, a junior studying religious studies, agreed.

"I think it should be kicked off because the military is a manifestation of callousness, and therefore we should deal with it as such," he said.

"For me, the presence of the ROTC on our campus is another aspect of the escalation of the militarization of our country, and I would like to see the U of O be the first to eliminate that program," said Katherine Gorham, a graduate student in secondary education.

"It is an autonomous organization that doesn't have a place in the University," she added.

Senior Dan Padgett believes the ROTC should conform to University Affirmative Action guidelines.

"If we have certain guidelines on affirmative action, then they should follow the rules or be kicked off campus," he said.

Tod Kelly, a junior majoring in music and political science, thinks the ROTC should remain on campus even though he doesn't agree with what it advocates.

"I'm not sure we have the right to kick out a group like that, just like we don't have a right to kick out GALA (Gay and Lesbian Alliance) simply because we don't agree with

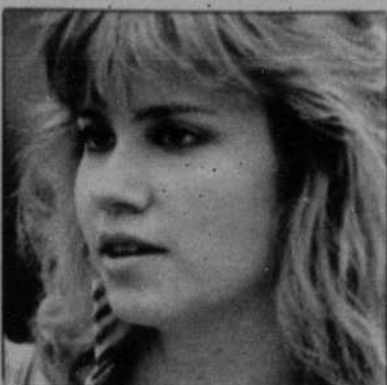

their views. The Conservatives should have an outlet for their views just as any other group does," he said.
