Rosier needs guidance regarding independent living, socialization and vocational planning, Prickell said.

"He continues to have problems making friends and maintaining them," he said. "This is very characteristic of a head-injured person."

Crebar said he thinks Rosier now can think about only one thing at a time.

"He doesn't have the mental capabilities he once had," Crebar said. "In fact, he's kind of slow... he doesn't get some jokes with double meanings."

Although Rosier is currently studying at LCC, Prickell said Rosier could not handle the study workload at a four-year university.

"I hate to be negative, but I don't see a potential for him making it (at a university)," Prickell said. "The problem is that he's not fast enough and doesn't make his decisions quickly."

Rosier is passing his classes at LCC, however, said defense attorney Ralph Cobb.

But Rosier only can handle the work at the community college level because he receives more help and understanding from his instructors than he would at a four-year institution, Prickell said.

Rob Ratcliffe, a former Kappa Sigma pledge who also was taken on the road trip in 1981, testified that no alcohol was given to the pledges at the fraternity house.

The road trip was a planned event and he and his roommate were aware that it would take place, Ratcliffe said. He said he was not aware if Rosier placed himself in any danger.

"We were all having a real good time enjoying ourselves," he said.

Ratcliffe said he saw the approaching headlights of the car that hit Rosier and Pierce shining on nearby trees.

"I was surprised at how fast the car came. I thought there was no real cause of alarm. I didn't think there would be any problem with everyone getting off the road in time," Ratcliffe said.

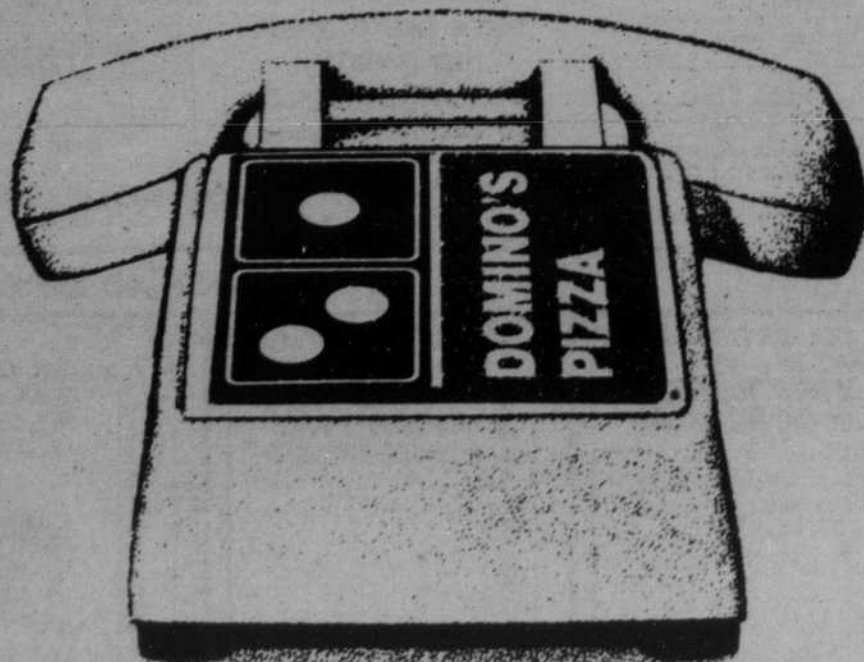

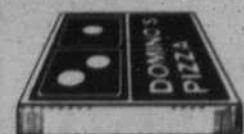
