## Oregon spikers take on the best in Washington State

To hell with saving the best for last. The Oregon men's track and field team will be facing its biggest dual meet of the season when the Washington State University Cougars roar into Hayward Field on Saturday.

The meet is scheduled to begin at noon with women's events. Men's events will begin at 12:30 p.m. with the hammer throw.

Under WSU head coach John Chaplin, the Cougars have won 58-straight dual meets, including a string of

five-straight over the Ducks. Last season, the Ducks finished with a 4-3 dual meet record and lost to Washington State, 104-58.

Although Oregon may have its best chance in years to beat the Cougars, WSU is returning with some very strong performers. In the first event of the day, a long-brewing battle in the hammer throw will kick the day off with a bang.

Oregon senior Ken Flax and WSU's Tore Gustafsson will meet for the fourth time Saturday. In last year's dual meet in Pullman, Wash., Gustafsson beat Flax's 240-3 with a throw of 243-4. Flax then beat

Gustafsson at the Pacific-10 Conference championships before Gustafsson won the NCAA title with Flax in third place.

Junior Uchenna Agu, who flew to a personal best, and NCAA-qualifying, 26- $\frac{1}{4}$  in the long jump during last week's Texas Relays, will be tested by Washington State's Demetrios Arauzos. Arauzos has a best of 25-8 $\frac{1}{4}$ .

On the track, the Cougars lost long-distance ace Richard Tuwei to graduation but retain Olympic gold medalist Julius Korir, who could run anything from the 3,000-meter steeplechase to the 1,500 meters.

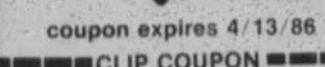

# REDS

**REDS** is the intellectual's *Dr. Zhivago*: a sweeping romantic epic full of passion and history. It is the story of journalists John Reed and Louise Bryant, their love, and the turbulent times in which they lived.

**REDS** is Warren Beatty's personal triumph.
