## Nu Shooz to play benefit dance

Portland dance band Nu Shooz and the Sigma Chi fraternity are working "in concert" to aid a Denver home for mentally and emotionally-disturbed children.

Nu Shooz will invade the Lane County Fairgrounds Performance Hall for a Saturday night benefit concert and dance, beginning at 8:00. The Atlantic recording artists are touring in support of their hit single "I Can't Wait," from their forthcoming album "Poolside."

Sigma Chi is co-sponsoring the benefit as part of its Derby Days Philanthropy. According to member-promoter John Uppendahl, the University chapter hopes to raise \$2,000 for the Cleo Wallace Village

for Children through Derby Days. The village is a home, school and rehabilitation center for mentally and emotionally-disturbed youngsters between ages five and 18, located just outside of Denver.

Saturday night, concertgoers will enjoy moving to the Nu Shooz beat on a 22,000-square foot dance floor. As a dance band, Nu Shooz is taking advantage of the situation by making this one of its largest Northwest productions.

Sigma Chi adopted Cleo Wallace Village as its international service project in 1967. In 1980, the fraternity established the John Wayne Endowment Fund to recognize the efforts that the late actor and Sigma Chi

alumnus made on behalf of the village. The fund helps provide village services to needy children. Uppendahl says that last year, the international fraternity donated more than \$100,000 to the village.

KSND-FM is co-sponsoring the benefit with Sigma Chi. Advance tickets for the Nu Shooz concert and dance cost \$4 and are available at the EMU Main Desk, Face the Music, Earth River Records and Everybody's Records. Day-of-show tickets cost \$5 and are available at all outlets as well as the Fairgrounds' Performance Hall box office.
