

Whittones, Harmaniacs to sing

The Whittones, Eugene's premier a cappella group, had so much fun at their "Seventh Birthday Party Gig" at the Oregon Electric Station last March that they decided to go one better with two return engagements May 16-17, featuring Ashland's vocal quartet The Harmaniacs.

The Harmaniacs, a zany group of two women and two men, are the darlings of Southern Oregon, and Eugene better get ready for quite a night because both

bands plan to have the joint rockin'.

The Whittones will be performing their special brand of tunes from the '50s and '60s. One moment they might break into a doo-wop ditty like "Duke Of Earl," and the next moment they'll sing a classic oldie but goodie like "I'll Be Seeing You." Their crushed purple velvet tuxedos and slicked back hair set the tone for an enjoyable evening of fond memories from "the good ole' days."

The Harmaniacs performance blends sophisticated vocal arrangements with offbeat comedy sketches. The repertoire ranges from upbeat renditions of Andrew Sisters style tunes like "Chattanooga Choo-Choo," through the '60s with "Walk On The Wild Side," to the here and now with Cindi Lauper and The Nylons.

Doors will open at 8:30 p.m. and showtime is 9:15. There is a \$2 cover charge.

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T-Birds roll into Hult



Red-hot rhythm 'n' blues will be rollin' into town Tuesday night when The Fabulous Thunderbirds perform in the Silva Concert Hall at the Hult Center.

The T-Bird story began 18 years ago in Dallas, Texas when Jimmie Vaughan began playing guitar along with his brother Stevie Ray. One year later, Jimmie was in his first teenage combo, playing the classic blues and rhythm 'n' blues of greats like B. B. King, Fats Domino, Freddie King and Jimmy Reed.

In 1975 jimmy, together with

ace blues harpist Kim Wilson, formed the Fabulous Thunderbirds and made the legendary blues joint Antone's their homebase. The T-Birds hit the road and left a trail of successful shows and albums, including gigs with the Rolling Stones and a recent CBS Associated Record release Tuff Enuff.

The Razorbacks will open the concert with a performance beginning at 8:00 p.m. Reserved tickets are \$10 and are available at all Hult Center outlets. For more information call 485-5200.



Ex-Groovy Roy Loney ready to set Max's aflame

Roy Loney will shake some action this weekend in Eugene as this former Flaming Groovy plays the Beer Gardens tonight, followed by a two-night gig at Max's Tavern on Friday and Saturday night. Loney will be bringing his classic roots rock sound that was first honed with '60s San Francisco band, the Flaming Groovies. As lead singer and wildman of the band, the Groovies attracted a cult following in the Fillmore-Avalon-Matrix-Straight Theatre circuit.

After a few critically successful records, Loney left the Groovies and then resurfaced in 1978 at the height of New Wave and was hailed for his strong comeback. Garage and pub bands found in Loney a model of stripped-down, rock 'n' roll.

The shows at Max's will start tonight and Saturday at 9:30 with local rockers, the Nadz opening up. There will be a \$3 cover charge. The Nadz will also open up at the Beer Gardens at 4 p.m.

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
