

Vandeweghe happy in Portland

PORTLAND, Ore. (AP)—Kiki Vandeweghe says reports that he wants to play for a team in a major media market, such as New York, next season are untrue.

"I think there have been a couple of articles about that," he said Wednesday, "but anytime anybody's asked me I've said I'm very happy where I am."

The high-scoring forward is a free agent after completing his second season with the Portland Trail Blazers, but he said in a telephone interview

from his home in Los Angeles that he hopes to work out a deal to remain in Portland.

"We've had one meeting with them. Things went well, I guess," he said. "You know it's one of those things that's not going to happen overnight. But I hope we can work something out."

Trail Blazer owner Larry Weinberg has said he will match any offer made to Vandeweghe by another NBA club.

"That's obviously very nice," Vandeweghe said, "and I appreciate it."

The Oregon golf team slipped to 15th place after the second round of the NCAA golf tournament being played in Winston-Salem, N.C. Thursday.

Oregon shot a team score of 298 to go along with its opening round of 293 for a 591 total that is 18 strokes off the pace set by Oklahoma State and Oklahoma.

The Duck's George Daves shot a second consecutive 71 to move into third place overall at 142.

Steve Rintoul shot a 75 to come in at 149, Rob Huffshot a 76 to also come in at 149, while Tony Joyner fired a 76 to come in at 151, and Croy Cochran fired a second consecutive 80.

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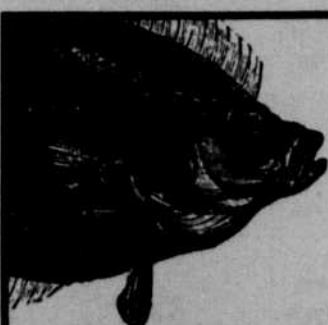
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
