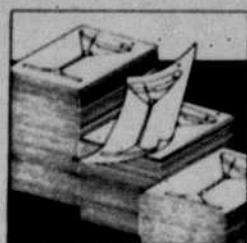


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Faculty members, former dean awarded for teaching, research

Twelve University faculty members and a former dean of the School of Law recently have received awards for teaching and scholarship.

Michael Posner, psychology, has been elected to the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He is one of two Oregonians elected to the academy this year, and the fourth University faculty member ever to be elected.

Posner, who is on leave of absence this year, has done research since 1960 on brain injuries, the aging process and the ability of people to concentrate despite distractions.

Chapin Clark, dean of the University School of Law from 1974-80, will receive the Charles E. Johnson Memorial Award at the graduation ceremony Sunday. The award, named after the acting University president during the 1968-69 school year who died in 1969, is for support of freedom of speech, adaptability to change and openness to all ideas.

Also at the graduation ceremony, two professors will receive the 1986 Ersted Awards for Distinguished Teaching. Morton Gernsbacher, psychology, and George Sheridan Jr., history, will get \$1,000 cash prizes along with the awards.

Gernsbacher, who has been at the University since 1983, has received awards from the University, the Office of Naval Research, the American Psychological Association and the National Institutes of Mental Health. Sheridan has taught at the University since 1976, and received a Faculty Research Award in 1978.

Three professors will receive Burlington Northern Foundation Faculty Achievement Awards at the ceremony. Awards of \$2,000 will be given to Maradel Krummel Gale, urban planning; Gloria Johnson, English; and Robert Smith, economics and business administration.

Gale has worked with the U.S. Forest Service, the Bureau of Land Management and the Peace Corps in planning activities and developing policy. Johnson, a specialist in Shakespeare, has taught at the University since 1956. She has been awarded a Fulbright scholarship and an Ersted Award. Smith, a University faculty member for 23 years, has served with the Federal Trade Commission, the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development and the U.S. Department of Labor.

Richard Kraus, political science, and Barry Naughton, economics, received awards for Chinese studies from the American Council of Learned Societies and the Social Science Research Council. The awards are intended to finance research expenses.

Paul Slovic, an adjunct professor in psychology, was awarded a research grant from the John Simon Guggenheim Memorial Foundation. Slovic is one of 272 scholars, scientists and artists in the United States and Canada to win Guggenheim awards for the 1986-87 school year, and one of 42 current University faculty members who have won them.

Jack Straton, a physics research assistant, will work for a year aiding atomic theorists at the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's Goddard Space Flight Center in Maryland. Straton's trip comes out of a research associateship awarded by the National Research Council and NASA.

A three-year, \$180,000 research grant will go to Assistant Biology Professor Judith Eisen, who has been named a Searle Scholar.

Marion Walter, a mathematics professor, has won honorable mention in the New York Academy of Sciences children's science book competition for her entry, "The Mirror Puzzle Book."

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
