

# New program will allow students to study in France

A new academic program in Eugene will give local high school students a chance to study overseas this fall.

Sixty-five Eugene-area high school students will leave in September for Villard de Lans, France, to continue their studies in conjunction with a study-abroad program sponsored by the Paideia School, 250 Silver Lane.

Jackie Victor, organizer of the Paideia program and a French instructor at North Eugene High School, first conceived the idea five years ago but waited until 1983 to begin coordinating the effort.

Five teachers, a secretary and three dormitory supervisors will accompany the group on the voyage, which is

designed to enrich the high school experience, Victor said.

"What is special about our program is that students can basically experience a culture as they feel comfortable," she said. "They will have the dorm and staff readily available to make sure things are going well for them, yet we also want to encourage them to spend as much time with the local French kids as possible."

Students will be housed in a boarding school that rests within Villard de Lans at the foot of the French Alps.

Though no prior knowledge of the French language is necessary, students are required to enroll in a French class while in the program. They will receive credit while studying Eugene 4-J High School District curriculum, including

European literature, journal writing and beginning skiing. Students also will have the opportunity to take classes at one of the local French schools.

Five monthly excursions will give smaller groups of students a chance to explore nearby locations such as Nimes, and Geneva, Switzerland. Additional long-term trips are planned for Amsterdam, Rome, Paris and Munich.

Theresa Roberts, a high school junior who traveled to Europe previously with her parents, said she is looking forward

to the trip. Italy is her favorite European country because of its "warm people," she said.

Chris Clarke, who will spend two terms in the program, is currently doing yardwork to finance the venture. When asked if he was excited about going to Europe, Clarke replied, "You know it, dude."

Costs for the first trimester are \$2,000, and each additional term costs \$1,000.

## Fiesta, concert set for Thursday

You'll either be there or you'll wish you were there, says Robert Guitteau about Thursday afternoon's Fiesta in the Park.

Guitteau, publicity director for Nicaragua Friendship Day, says the fundraising event will include a free evening concert and picnic at Skinner Butte Park.

The event is being sponsored by the Council for Human Rights in Latin America in an effort to pay shipping costs on the more than \$75,000 in medical supplies already collected by the council, Guitteau says. About \$7,000 is needed to send the supplies to hospitals in Nicaragua, he says.

"Right now the medical supplies are just sitting in storage and we're having to pay to store them," says David Salem, a council member. "We can't keep collecting the supplies and holding on to them. We've got to get them down there."

"Nearly every day we wait, the costs of shipping to Nicaragua are going up, and the avenues for shipping are becoming fewer," Guitteau says.

The medical supplies have been collected from throughout the Northwest during the past year, Guitteau says.

The seventh annual Fiesta in the Park will feature five bands, including the Nicaraguan band, Igni-Tawanka, and local bands Sandunga, Caliente and Balafon. Grupo Moncada, called "one of the most versatile groups of Cuban and Latin American musicians today," was a last minute addition to the field. All performances are free.

The council is asking people to purchase commemorative buttons at the event for a minimum donation of \$3. The donations will go toward paying the costs of shipping the medical supplies.

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
