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the scoreboard with a two-yard touchdown run by Day 5:25 into the contest. A 56-yard punt return by Anthony Parker put the Sun Devils on the Oregon

eight-yard line and set up Day's run.

The Ducks came right back at the Sun Devils on their next possession. Miller connected with flanker Rod Green and tight end Bobby DeBisschop for 31 and 21 yards, respectively, on the drive. But ASU's defense held tight when free safety Darin Willis broke up Miller's pass to DeBisschop in the end zone on third down and three. Matt MacLeod culminated the drive with a 34-yard field goal to make it 7-3.

Less than three minutes later, the Sun Devils scored again when Bruce Hill waltzed into the end zone on a reverse play good for 22 yards and a 14-3 advantage.

The Ducks countered ASU's touchdown with a score of their own on their next possession. Miller hit Green, who finished the day with seven receptions for 139 yards, for 28 and 15 yards en route to his own touchdown reception to end the first quarter and bring the Ducks

within reach 14-10.

Oregon's defense held ASU on the following series, but watched its momentum disappear when its offense could not produce any points near the end of the second quarter after sustaining an impressive drive down to the Arizona 14.

ASU recovered the momentum and scored on the Van Raaphorst-Hill connection.

The Sun Devils put the game out of reach when they scored on their first possession of the second half, pushing the lead to 27-10. On ASU's third play, only 1:01 into the third quarter, Van Raaphorst fired a 63-yard pass to Day, who was wide open after slipping past Oregon's secondary.

The Ducks managed to put their final touchdown on the board near the end of the third quarter when Berry bounced off an ASU lineman and scooted in for the score from one yard out, making it 30-17.

Both teams then exchanged possessions before the Sun

Devils added one final touchdown. Van Raaphorst connected with Darin Tupper coming out of the backfield for a nine-yard scoring strike to put the icing on the cake.

"We had to play a mistake-free game and near perfect to win," Brooks said. "We fumble the ball, we throw an interception and let them (ASU) have a fairly easy punt return to set up another score down there."

Brooks knows that his team cannot afford to make such mistakes against a team the caliber of ASU.

"Arizona State is certainly as good as the last three teams we've played," Brooks said. "ASU is a very fine football team with maybe the strongest offensive line we've seen."

ASU head coach John Cooper, whose team improved to 4-0-1 on the season, had praise for his opponent as well.

"Oregon is the best offensive team we've played," Cooper said.

But offense isn't everything, and Brooks knows exactly what the team has to do at this point in the season.

"What we need to do is regroup a bit and start playing error-free football."
