

Auction to help fund Athletic Department, teams

The Oregon Athletic Department and some individual sports will benefit from the proceeds amassed at "Oregon Auction '86" Friday at the Valley River Inn.

The evening will commence with a silent auction at 5:30 p.m., and will feature more than eighty items of low value (under \$100). Many of these include celebrity-type items such as a framed autographed poster

of Alabama, a golf visor from Arnold Palmer, an autographed baseball from Dale Murphy and an autographed volleyball from Tom Selleck.

Dinner will follow the silent auction, and then an oral auction will place larger items up for bid at 8:30 p.m.

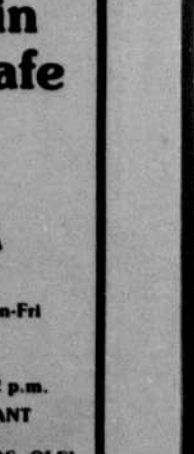
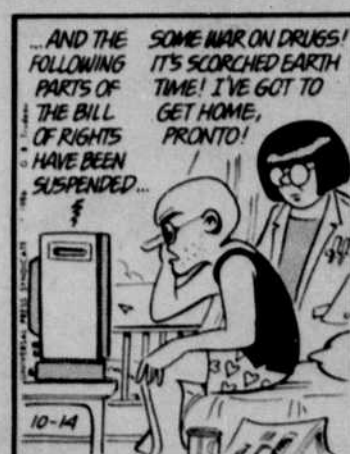
