

side doesn't — the other side sees this as a defensive weapon because they don't trust you," Hovet said.

"This really raises the question of reality whether they (the United States) want an agreement. In the process of the discussions (at Iceland), they momentarily agreed to eliminate all nuclear weapons, and then who got upset — the military. So it is a bargaining chip — it's

a bargaining chip to assure that nothing in a summit negotiation would be acceptable to the other side," he said.

Swan, who served as moderator during most of the panel, said afterward that it is a battle between Reagan's technological dream and Gorbachev's economic dilemma, leading to a general feeling that the Soviets cannot afford to carry on the arms race in outer space.

That feeling goes just the opposite way in the United States, where one of every six Americans is employed as a result of the arms race, according to Hovet.

The audience asked questions following the discussion, and some of them concerned dealing with the possibility of an "obsolete" war and the frustration and uselessness some felt as members of a concerned public.

Johnson offered some encouragement. "If we didn't continue to struggle on this issue, where would we be today? I think we'd be in a lot worse situation if we didn't have a strong movement that opposes development of nuclear weapons and testing," Johnson said.

"We just have to redouble those efforts."

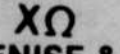

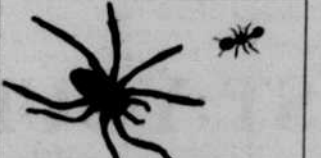
