# Stand-ins stump for candidates at ASUO, campus ministry forum

Supporters of gubernatorial candidates Neil Goldschmidt and Norma Paulus were at the University on Wednesday afternoon to stump for the two in a political forum in Room 101 of the EMU.

The forum was cosponsored by the ASUO and Campus Interfaith Ministry.

Jean Tate, a local real estate developer, represented Paulus.

Ted Kulongowski, the 1982 democratic candidate for governor who was defeated by current Gov. Vic Atiyeh, represented Goldschmidt.

Kulongowski and Tate both echoed the campaign declarations of Goldschmidt and Paulus and fielded questions

from an audience of about 40.

Going into the campaign's final weekend, late polls have indicated that the governor's race is a "dead heat." This follows the endorsements of Goldschmidt by the state's three largest newspapers: The Oregonian in Portland, The Statesman-Journal in Salem,

and The Register-Guard in Eugene.

Kulongowski went so far as to claim the election was "already over."

"Neil has caught and now moved past Norma (in the polls). The nail in the coffin
