assesment, clean-up and restoration.

A new security system will be installed in the laboratories.

"The security system is a multi-faceted issue, it does not

just include changing the locks," Stickrod said.

The raid conducted by the ALF fits almost perfectly into the pattern that has been seen at other institutions struck by the group, Stickrod said.

I think it is important that the community knows that the ALF is an international terrorist organization," Stickrod

The ALF has a history of raiding laboratories, and Stickrod believes there is a high possibility of them continuing raids around the country

They are not just some local vandals, and we will undoubtedly see more activity from them." he added.


