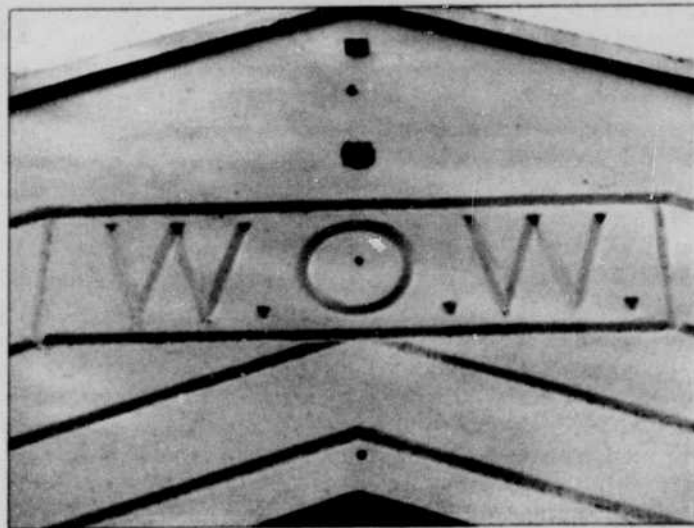

The Community Center for the Performing Arts is set to hold a benefit celebration on Nov. 15 to help keep the center, the historic Woodmen of the World Hall, open.
