The Trojans broke a five-game conference losing string with a victory at Arizona State University after losing big to the University of Arizona on the trip's first stop.

USC, 6-8 overall and 1-5 in the Pac-10, is led by forward Derrick Dowell, who averages 20.4 points and 9.1 rebounds a contest.

The Trojan defense has been known to utilize pressure against its opponents, forcing more than 17 turnovers a game.

Monson is concerned with

the momentum both UCLA and USC have going into the Ducks' upcoming pair of games: "UCLA wins a game in the last minute on the road to give them momentum and USC also wins on the road. Now we have to go down into that area with them having the momentum."

But Oregon has a few of its own weapons to counter that momentum — most notably guard Anthony Taylor.

The 6-foot-4 junior has scored 20 or more points in 11 of the Ducks' 14 games, chalking up a

20.5 average (21.6 in conference play).

Taylor also leads the team in steals and has played more minutes than any other Ducks player. His 4.9 rebounding clip puts him third on the squad in that category.

On the rebounding end for the Ducks, center Sven Meyer is averaging 7.8 rebounds a contest, including an 8.5 mark in Pac-10 play. Meyer is second to Taylor in the scoring column with 13.8 a game.

The only other Duck in double figures is guard David Girley (11.2 points a game) who has exhibited proficient shooting from the three-point vicinity. Girley has hit 27 of 49 (.551) this season, compared to his .383 (18 of 47) statistic from inside the three-point arc.

Although early, the conference race is definitely up for grabs. Every team has at least one loss: the University of Washington is the only squad with just one setback, while seven teams have recorded two losses.

"It's important for us to get some road victories," Monson said. "To do anything in the league you have to win some on the road."

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
