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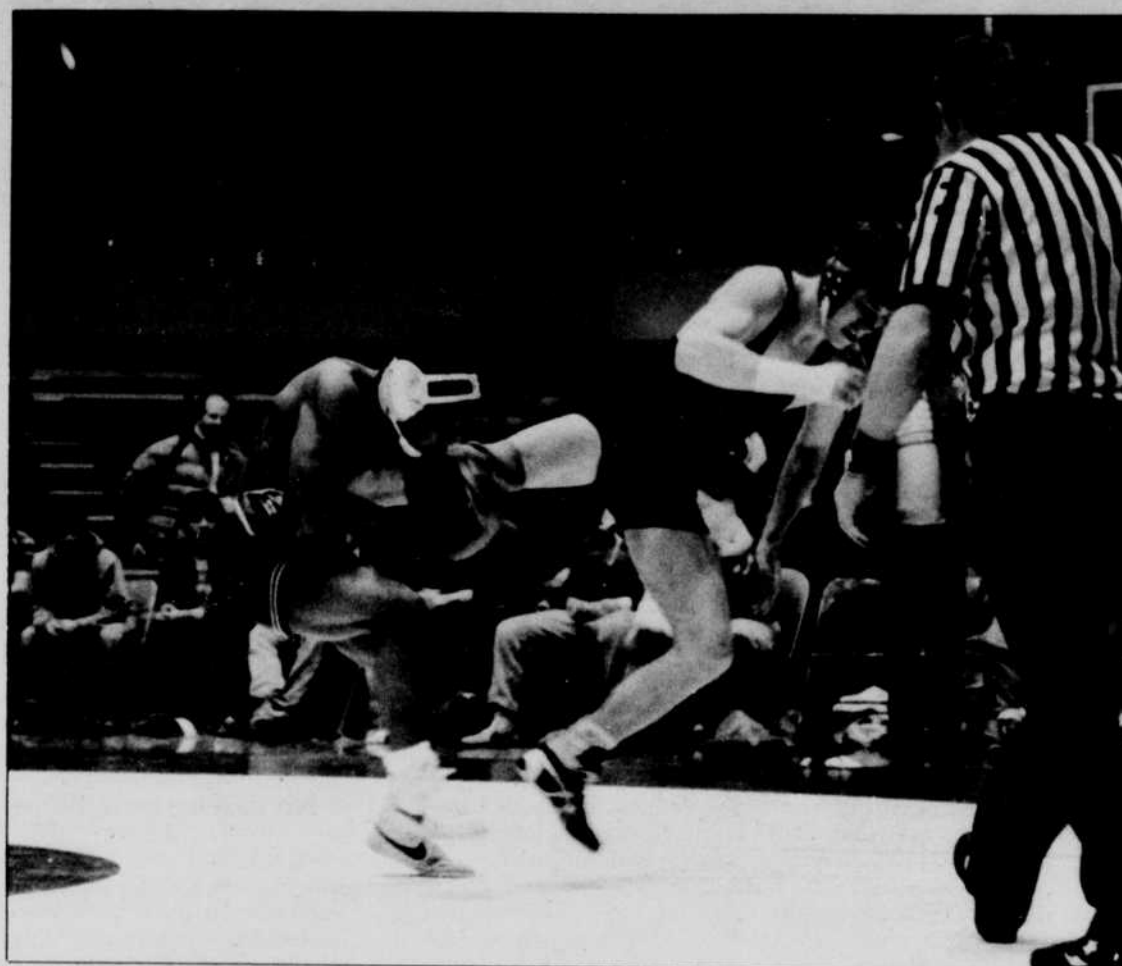

Battered matmen suffer losses

Heading into Saturday's Civil

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War wrestling meet at McArthur Court, Oregon coach Ron Finley expected a close, "probably within six points," score.

But the healthy Beavers outmanned the injury-plagued Ducks for the tenth straight time, 27-13. Oregon's last win over the pesky Beavers was in 1982.

In Friday's dual meet action, Portland State University won its second narrow dual match of the season over the Ducks, 24-21. Then Big 10 Conference power Minnesota pinned Oregon 40-7 in the second dual.

From the beginning, Oregon was outnumbered. Knee injuries have sidelined 134-pounder Glen Jarrett, a national qualifier last season; 150-pounder George Johnston; and heavyweight freshman Cam Strahm.

To add insult to injury, Jarrett's phenomenal replacement, Tim Ige, quit for personal reasons, and Strahm's backup, James Knott, who was pulled out of red-shirt, won't be able to see action for two weeks until his knee brace is constructed. Oregon was forced to forfeit its heavyweight matches.

"We just don't have enough depth to get the job done," Finley said. "We need some help."

When asked if the outcome might have been different Saturday if Oregon were healthy, Finley said, "I don't think Oregon State is that good of a team. We've just got to get some more experience. I felt we had a good chance to beat them but we just didn't get the job done."

"But they've got a darn good heavyweight (Dave Orndorff, who won the heavyweight championship at the Oregon Invitational Dec. 21). I'm not sure if we could find anyone to beat him," Finley added.

Saturday, 118-pounder Roberto Pelayo, who went undefeated over the weekend, got the Ducks off to a fast lead, beating OSU's Horacio Arce, 7-3.

"Roberto is doing a fine job," Finley said. "He's been improving every year for us. He's one of our good, steady performers."

Shon Lewis followed up Pelayo, thumping 126-pound

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
