basketball action Monday night at McArthur Court.

"It was one of those games where they had nothing to lose, and we went in a little cold," Heiny said.

Oregon guard Lauri Landerholm added the same sentiments: "It's real hard coming backing after losing two down in L.A. It showed that we were a little bit drained and

lacked the concentration that we needed," she said.

And how. The Pilots came out and hit the Ducks — and the boards — with everything they had. The two teams traded buckets for most of the first half before Oregon could muster a three-point lead, 34-31, at the intermission, thanks mostly to three straight buckets down low by 6-foot-7 Stefanie Kasperski.

But Portland came out the second half and caught the Ducks napping. Just like that, the Pilots had their biggest lead of the night, 37-34, after Toni Kent hit the easy layup for two of her game-high 26 points.

Oregon regained its composure, scrapped the zone defense and went to work. Carol Drouet hit the long jumper to

cut the lead to one and then stole the ball on the in-bounds play to regain possession. Guard Jacquie Semeniuk hit one of two free throws after a foul underneath the bucket, and the score was knotted at 47.

The Pilots turned the ball over again, and Landerholm responded at the other end with a rebound basket to give the

Ducks the lead. Center Gabi Neumann scored Oregon's seventh straight point, and the Ducks were back in control, 51-47.

One very promising note to emerge from this game was the season-high performance of the freshman Kasperski, who netted 17 points, nine rebounds and three blocked shots to lead the Ducks.

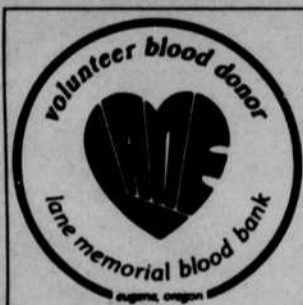
