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ing onto the site that will include astronomer Carl Sagan and actor Martin Sheen.

They plan to be arrested, in part, so that the legality of U.S. nuclear testing can be brought to trial, according to a newsletter distributed by Citizen Action for Lasting Security.

As a defense, protesters plan to cite the Nuremberg Treaty, of which the United States is a signatory. The treaty, according to the protesters, makes it a moral obligation of citizens to resist any actions by the government that would result in massive loss of civilian life.

Two days of activities are planned, revolving around the protest rally on Thursday. A non-violence workshop, a national press conference and a public address by Carl Sagan will be held Wednesday.

"Professors have been really supportive and have rescheduled tests for me," said Kimberly Sargent, a sophomore at the University who plans to take the week off to attend the protest. Taking part in the demonstra-

tion is important to her "because this is one way to make people wake up, to make them listen," she said.

Cozart said attending the protest will give her a better sense of personal involvement in the peace movement. In the past, her dedication to the movement took on more of an intellectual form, she said. Now she wants to get a feeling for the good she can accomplish through the

movement, she said, and to be with people who share similar views.

CALS, an Oregon peace group, is organizing car pools leaving from Eugene on Tuesday. A caravan leaving for the test site is scheduled to depart from the Growers' Market, 454 Willamette Street, on Tuesday at 6 p.m. For more information about car pools, call CALS at 343-8548.

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choke a man to death, he said.

The next memory Randy had was of waking up in the barracks with guards posted outside his door, which is when he finally knew he needed help, he said.

Randy attended an Alcoholics Anonymous meeting because the organization had helped his father and his grandfather overcome their drinking problems, he said.

"The only requirement a person must meet to join AA is to have the desire to stop drinking," said Earl, coordinator of the Eugene chapter of AA, who asked that his last name be withheld to uphold AA's policy of anonymity.

AA is "a fellowship of people sharing their common problem," Earl said. The organization's primary goal is to help the suffering alcoholic, which means each person there strives to make peace with himself or herself, he said.

If alcoholics are never honest with themselves, they cannot get help, Earl said. "There's no one who can help alcoholics except themselves," he said. "The program will work if the

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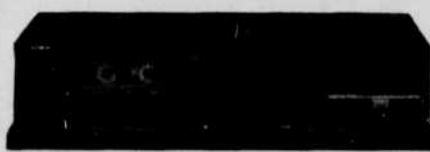
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
