The 177-pound bout was all tied up at five before Stockwell was awarded one point for riding time at the end of the match.

Oregon's Chuck Kearney, upping his record to 23-6, scored an important technical fall over Vince Littrell in the 190-pound matchup. The second-round technical fall gave the Ducks a 19-13 cushion with only the heavyweight match remaining.

James Knott assured the Ducks of the team victory with the heavyweight win, 10-5, over Brian Beadle.

The Ducks now have more

than two weeks to prepare for their final dual meet of the season against Oregon State University (Feb. 27) in Corvallis.
