## The Lost Falcons

The Lost Falcons are back home after backing up nationally known rhythm and blues singer Screamin' Jay Hawkins. After a wild New Year's Eve show in Portland, Hawkins was impressed enough to take the band to Seattle with him to finish out the last four dates of his tour. He also has asked the band to join him for some future dates in Hollywood.

The group features Henry Cooper on guitar, harmonica and vocals; Johnny Be on guitar, accordion and vocals; Andy Strange on bass and Boyd Small on drums and vocals.

The band has been described as a highly professional rock 'n' roll act that still manages to sound like hellraisers who just stepped out of the garage. When they break into the Johnny Kidd and the Pirates classic, Shakin' All Over, it's like a controlled explosion.

The Lost Falcons will be at Old Taylors' Tavern, 894 E. 13th Ave., Friday night, where they are a regular feature. They will play for the Valentine's Day crowd Saturday night at Max's Tavern.

The Flies, a high-powered rock 'n' roll trio, will open the show at Max's. This will be the Eugene debut for the newly formed group that features ex-Milkman Randy Haines on guitar and vocals, ex-Soulsations bassist Tom Jacobs and drummer Jeff Strawbridge from the Imposters. The Flies play classic '60s and original music.
