## Civil War revenge

# Duck women rip OSU, 71-51

There was no denying this Civil War.

Oregon fans can regain some solace from Thursday night's tragedy in the fact that the women's basketball team took their show to Corvallis, whipped Oregon State University in every phase of the game right on its home court — and won.

With the Friday's suprising 71-51 blowout, Oregon settles itself more firmly at third place in the Pacific-10 Conference with a 9-3 mark (17-5 overall). And while the Ducks are preparing their run at a league championship this week, they can look back at this game — their fifth-straight victory and eighth in the last nine games — as one of their best of the

season.

The Ducks turned the tables on the defensively-sound Beavers with a sort of malaligned 3-2 zone defense Oregon coach Elwin Heiny borrowed from the playbook of Don Monson, the Oregon men's coach. OSU suffered through offensive droughts in both halves as a result, and were hampered into shooting 33 percent for the game (Oregon shot 55 percent).

The offense displayed what was perhaps their best inside-outside transition of the year. When the flailing OSU defense stuck like glue on Oregon's outlet players, Lauri Landerholm and Jacquie Semeniuk simply tossed the ball over outstretched arms into the waiting hands of 6-foot-7 freshman Stefanie Kasperski or

6-foot-3 Kris Glidden. And if OSU packed the defense down low, Landerholm countered with an open jumper or drive to the basket.

The Ducks also got solid minutes out of guard Carol Drouet and forward Sheila Sattiewhite, although neither player scored a point. Drouet started her first game since going down with a knee injury against Stanford University, and endured 31 minutes of pushing the ball up the court against the relentless pressure of OSU's Cynthia Jackson. Sattiewhite played 25 minutes and fouled out, but she had some key rebounds in an outstanding defensive effort.

"I think we just found the right, do you say correlation," said the West German Kasperski.

"Combination," corrected Landerholm.

Whatever it was, it worked. Kasperski dominated the Beavers better than she does her command of the English vocabulary, and tallied a career high 22 points to go along with 13 rebounds, eight of those on the offensive end.

The senior Landerholm, last week's Pac-10 Player of the Week, finished with a game-high and Civil War-best 24

The University of Oregon Indoor Soccer Tournament championship went down to the wire Saturday, with Team Norway, a group of Norwegian students, claiming the title in the final game of the tourney 3-1 over the Zebras.

The Zebras, a local team thrown together at the last minute due to the abrupt withdrawal of Pacific University, placed second and UO's club sports team Buds F.C. finished third in the two-day tournament in Gerlinger Annex.

Team Norway and the Zebras both finished the tournament with identical 3-1-1 records, while Buds F.C. was 1-2-2. Buds F.C. was the only team to defeat Team Norway (2-0).

Salvador Reyes, a member of the Boon's team out of Salem, was named the tournament most valuable player.


