

•Kaumeyer, out of Palomar Junior College in California, was a highly touted cornerback who made the Junior College Gridwire All-America team. Brooks noted that Kaumeyer comes in with high credentials and will be filling a position where the Ducks need some help.

•Reed, a junior college transfer out of Pasadena, Calif., is another signee who is coming into a position where Oregon lacks depth, Brooks said.

•Whitney, an outside linebacker from Ventura Junior College, possesses a lot of speed which has allowed him to make

plays in all areas of the field, according to Brooks.

As far as the high school signees are concerned, Brooks said it is hard to tell just how much, or if, they will contribute as freshmen.

"How well it stacks up won't

be determined until we get them on campus in the fall," Brooks said.

Among the top high school recruits are all-state running backs Kyle Kozak of AAA state champion Glencoe, Greg Byrne of AA state champion Dallas and Darron McCarty of Canby.

However, all three will probably be converted to defensive backs.

Local signees include quarterback Bob Brothers (Marist High School), offensive lineman John Niemela (North Eugene High) and fullback Geno Zaharie (South Eugene High).

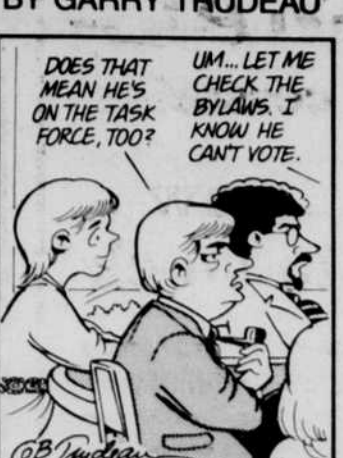
