A part-time job in the Army Reserve has just become an even smarter way to work your way through college. The Army Reserve now has its own GI Bill, and if you qualify, you can receive up to \$5,040 for college while you attend college.

But the GI Bill isn't the only valuable thing about being an Army Reservist. You'll also be paid for training in one of over 300 skills.

In addition, you'll earn at least \$1,870 a year for serving two days a month (usually on weekends) at your

local Army Reserve Center, and attending two weeks of annual training. And if you take out a student loan, you may qualify for a program that can help you repay it.

With the GI Bill to help with tuition, and your monthly Army Reserve salary to help with other expenses, you could earn over \$16,000 for college in one enlistment.
