Ducks to wrap up league schedule

Once again, the Oregon men's basketball team will be put to the test.

The Ducks are faced with the task of picking themselves up after Sunday's 102-71 rout by UCLA — a loss that undoubtedly left Coach Don Monson and his team baffled.

After the UCLA game — Oregon's worst home loss in 19 years — Monson said he was left without many answers regarding the loss and the remainder of the season.

There may be no consolation for such a beating, but the Bruins did play brilliantly, shooting the lights out in McArthur Court.

But Monson knows that Oregon's problem right now is not UCLA, but the upcoming two weeks of action — their final two conference games and the Pacific 10 Conference post-season tournament.

The Ducks must regroup and hit the road, where they haven't been too successful (2-9 overall and 1-6 against Pac-10 foes) this season.

Oregon wraps up its regular season and conference schedule in Washington this weekend where it will meet the University of Washington tonight in Seattle and Washington State University Saturday night in Pullman.

The Ducks swept the Washington schools in Eugene earlier this season, upending the Huskies, 77-67, and the Cougars, 60-55, in McArthur Court.

Guard Anthony Taylor sparked Oregon on both occasions, scoring 27 points against Washington and 22 against WSU. Taylor was superb in the second half of both games, igniting for 19 and 20 points, respectively.
