"It's been our standard practice, even though we don't have to, to do a full affirmative action hiring for appointments," she said, adding she went through this process when appointing members to the Elections Board,

who were confirmed at the Student Senate meeting Feb. 23.

Nelson stressed the difference between appointing and hiring. "When hiring someone we have to advertise for three days in the Oregon Daily Emerald

and leave it open for five," he said. "We have to send out notices to all the affirmative action-covered groups, and we have to put the phrase that the ASUO is an equal opportunity employer."

A Feb. 26 Emerald editorial took issue with the appointments of Jeff Wheeler to the Incidental Fee Committee and Katy Howard to the Insurance Committee because Wheeler is a member of Nelson's fraternity, and Howard is a member of the IFC.

Nelson said he respects the editorial board's opinion, but stands behind the appointments.

"Katy Howard was important for two reasons. One, she's got involvement in student government, which is nice," Nelson said.

In addition, Howard's appointment is important because she is a "non-traditional student," he said, referring to the fact that she is older than the average student.

There were three applicants for the IFC vacancy, not one as originally reported, Nelson said.

"I was looking for someone who was not strongly affiliated politically with any major political philosophy. Ideally, I was looking for someone who would be extremely fair, would not bring external politics into the fee committee," he said. Wheeler best met this criteria, he added.

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
