Ducks lose decisively to WSU; drop to seventh place in Pac-10

Saturday just wasn't the Oregon men's basketball team's day.

First, Washington State University's front line overpowered the Ducks with 58 points and 29 rebounds to give the Cougars a 79-65 afternoon victory in Pullman.

Then, Stanford upended Arizona State University (97-92) in overtime to break the tie between the Cardinal and the Ducks and claim sixth place in the Pacific 10 Conference final standings.

A win in Pullman would have given sixth place to the Ducks outright, but as it was, Stanford was left to decide Oregon's fate.

The Cardinal win allows them to sit out the opening day of the Goodyear/Pacific 10 Conference post-season tournament, while the Ducks will play USC Thursday at 9:00 p.m. at Pauley Pavilion in Los Angeles.

Oregon, dropping to 14-13 overall and 8-10 in the Pac-10 (1-8 in conference road games), was the victim of WSU's three-point shot accuracy and rebounding prowess.

The Cougars drilled eight of 16 shots from three-point range compared to the Ducks' meager three of 15 effort. WSU also outrebounded Oregon, 43-30.

Looking at the Cougars' front line production, it's plain to see how WSU was able to register the win so easily.

•Senior forward Dwayne Scholten, who averages 11 points a game, poured in 18 points and grabbed 11 rebounds.

•Senior forward Joe Wallace scored 15 points, brought down a career-high 13 boards and dished out five assists.

•Junior forward Brian Quinnett poured in 25 points, including five of eight three pointers, collected five rebounds and handed out four assists.

Meanwhile, the Ducks' front line was almost nonexistent. Center Sven Meyer was three of 11, and forwards Keith Balderston, Jesse Nash and Kenny Sprague shot a combined six of 20.

The Ducks found themselves down 34-27 at halftime, but came out early in the second half with renewed life.

Guard Anthony Taylor hit a couple of jumpers to pull the Ducks within three, 34-31, but

from there on out, Oregon couldn't find the bucket.

Quinnett was a perfect four of four from beyond the three-point line in the second half with 13:30 left, giving the Cougars a 50-36 advantage and

the momentum for the remainder of the game.

Taylor was the Ducks' top scorer with 16 points on seven of 14 from the field, and guard David Girley added 12.



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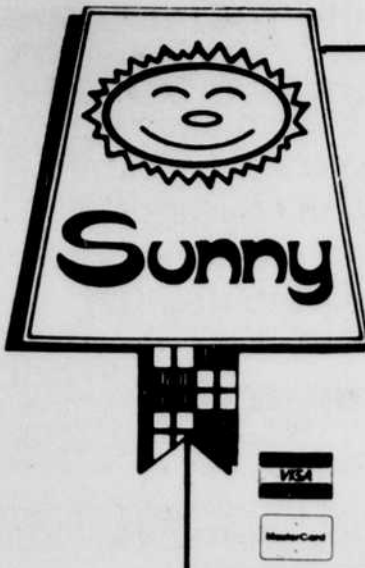


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
