Monday that "at least a couple of machines be put in all the complexes."

The recommendation was that the machines be put in both the male and female restrooms on the lower floors of the dorms, "where people can lock

the doors and buy a condom in private," according to Regan.

"A lot needs to be done" before this can happen, according to Residence Life Director Dick Romm. He said the housing department is currently looking for vendors and working with the health center about the specifications for the condoms in order to get the best protection.

Bernhardt said 25 percent of the profits from the vending machines will be funneled back into funding for AIDS education.

Moseley said the task force

also wants to broaden this program to include all living organizations, such as fraternities and sororities, because "there is a need for complete availability of condoms for risk reductions."

Professor Robert Kime of the School and Community Health Department said personal health classes also will be increasing their emphasis on AIDS awareness. "All of the Personal Health GTFs will be bringing the topic up in classes," he said.

The GTFs also will attend a meeting with Jackson before

spring term starts so Jackson "can bring them up to date" about AIDS, Kime said.

Bernhardt hopes the brown-bag forum will feature Ken Storer, the Director of the Shanti Project in Eugene. The Shanti Project is "an emotional support group for AIDS victims," according to Bernhardt.

A lot more information from national sources about AIDS now is available to students, according to Moseley. He said several new brochures have been published, and the University has acquired several video tapes and films on the subject.

Moseley said the resource material will be used in a variety of ways, such as incorporating it into fall orientation and taking it into the dorms, where small discussion groups will be held between students and staff members of the Student Health Center as well as used in health classes.
