During the three-hour session, community members aired their views on the four design plans presented by Elbasani & Logan Architects. Public concern ranged from project costs on the taxpayer to the need for more open spaces.

The plans are not final. These options are designed to elicit response and give the public a general idea of possible site plans, said Barry Elbasani of Elbasani & Logan Architects. By holding a public forum on these four design ideas, "we are looking for ways these plans can be recombined to address issues like open space and park-

ing options, he said.

The "extremity" of these design ideas are meant to prompt public reaction.

"We are attempting to reach a consensus on the design options presented or reach some agreement on the pieces of various schemes that people can agree they would like to see in the master site plan, said Frank Fuller of Elbasani & Logan Architects.

The strong public interest in the development of a master site plan for the Riverfront Research Park is a positive sign, said Eugene Mayor Brian Obie.

"We're hoping to have a long

term impact on the economy by providing jobs for the people that are being educated at the University of Oregon," he said. "At the same time we are hoping to provide a shift in our economic base by providing different types of industries to insulate the economy from the ups and downs of the national economy."

The Riverfront Research Park is a public/private joint venture between the University of Oregon and the City of Eugene that will be developed on the 71-acre site on the south bank of the Willamette River, adjacent to the University.
