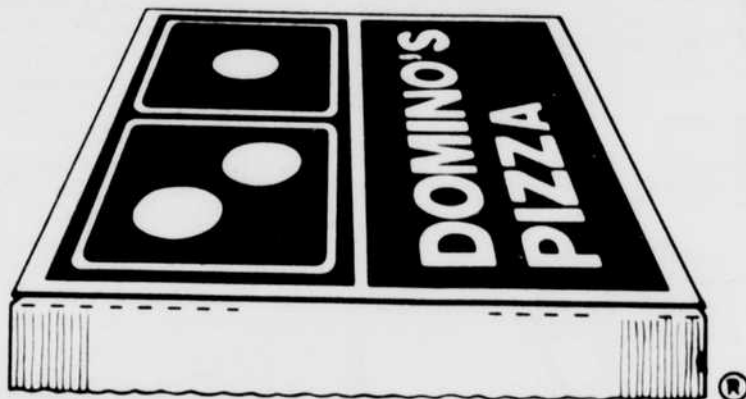
If the Oregon Legislature passes the gay rights bill cur-
