and jumping squad. "They could sweep both hurdle events and give us real trouble in the jumps," said Dellinger. The Bears boast three sub-14 second high hurdlers, a 55-foot triple jumper (Ken Williams) and two high jumpers who have exceeded 7-3. The Ducks will again rely on Dannis, J.J. Birden and Pat Lanning to prevent any sweeps.

"Those guys are what Bill Bowerman used to call 'tigers,'" said assistant coach John Gillespie. "Every time they line up, they stick their noses right in the middle of it and compete," he explained.

Two Oregon athletes in those events are questionable going into the meet Saturday. Horizontal jumper Latin Berry

may rest his tender heel if it appears the Ducks are comfortably ahead, and Davon Russell, who strained a hamstring against Washington three weeks ago, may compete in the 100 and 200 alongside Dannis.

Fans will definitely see the return of pole vaulter Tim Canfield, who will see his first action of the season. He teams with sophomore Jay Davis to

reunite the Pac-10's leading pole vaulters from a year ago.

Oregon has the edge in the distances and the strength events. "They've got one guy (British Royal Navy veteran David Ottaway) who could break in and mess us up at 800 or 1,500," said Gillespie.

He also noted that senior Dan Nelson will run his third consecutive steeplechase for the

Ducks. "That's got to be some kind of a record for us," he said.

Nelson owns the best steeple time for Oregon this year (8:46.70), and will be counted on to answer the challenge of Cal's Jason Flam (8:51.50). "This will be Dan's last one," promised Dellinger, who predicted Nelson would reach NCAA qualification (8:44.74) on Saturday.
