UCLA, finished three for four with a single, double, and a home run. Ford allowed six hits and struck out nine.

The nightcap was all UCLA, as Bruin pitcher Lisa Longaker worked on a no-hitter through five innings until Barnes singled to right with one out in the sixth. Longaker finished with a two-hitter and allowed no one past first base.

Both UCLA runs came in the

first inning, as Parks led off with a single and scored on Holstrom's two-run blast to left-center field, her second home run of the day.

"They're definitely the toughest team we've faced this year," King said. "We had a long game yesterday and we were a little tired. Defensively, we played great, but offensively, we needed some more hits."

"UCLA's a powerful team,"

Wilson added. "They're ranked fourth in the nation right now, but I have a feeling they're going to finish one or two. They have great hitting and pitching, and that's what you need."

The two losses dropped the Ducks to 19-26 overall, and 1-7 in Pacific 10 Conference. Oregon State University will be in town for a double-header Wednesday at 1 p.m. at Howe Field.

Chris Miller, Oregon's record-setting quarterback, is expected to be taken in the first round of the National Football League's annual draft of college football seniors this morning.

The event will be televised live on ESPN (cable 5) beginning at 5 a.m.

Miller will most likely become the sixth Oregon player in history to be drafted in the first round. San Diego, Green Bay, Dallas, Atlanta, Houston and the Los Angeles Raiders have all expressed interest in the two-time all-Pacific 10 Conference performer, who prepped at Eugene's Sheldon High School.

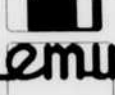

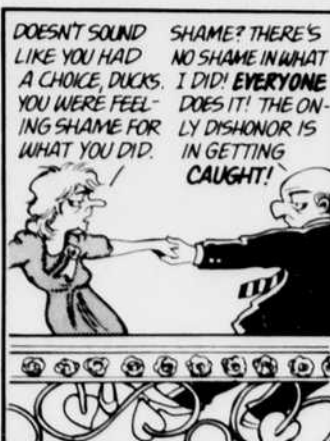
