

Ducks falter under 4th-ranked UCLA in double-header

After a double-header split with sixth-ranked University of California Sunday, the Oregon softball team could not repeat the magic as it dropped a pair of conference games to fourth-ranked UCLA Monday at Howe Field, 6-3 and 2-0.

The Bruins jumped on the Ducks early in game when UCLA's Sandra Arledge lined the second pitch of the game over the right field fence for a solo homer and a quick 1-0 lead.

Oregon pitcher Sue Voeller then walked Lisa Hankerd and gave up a single to Janice Parks, moving Hankerd to third.

With no outs, Gina Holstrom's fly ball to left field jumped the park for a three-run homer and a 4-0 UCLA lead.

Voeller was "just a little" shook up after serving up two round-trippers in the first inning.

"Especially the first one," she said. "It was a good pitch. I threw it low down at her knees. When it went out, I thought 'uh-oh, we're in trouble.'"

Coach Teresa Wilson agreed. "Naturally, it's going to rattle you a little when you give up four runs on hits like that in the

first inning. They were good pitches too. She (Arledge) just golfed it out of there," Voeller said.

UCLA pitcher Samantha Ford looked invincible through the first two innings, but the Ducks rallied in their half of the third when Jeanna King, Vicki Fry and Paula Barnes had consecutive singles to load the bases.

Then Arledge, the Bruins' leftfielder, mishandled a fly ball by Kira Lewis, allowing King to score. Fry was thrown out at the plate, but UCLA's third baseman, Parks, was called for "obstructing the runner" and the run was given to Oregon.

Stacye Gustafson drew a walk and the bases were full again. One out later, the Ducks' Cheryl Coryell singled up the middle, scoring Barnes, but Bruin centerfielder Karen Walker nailed Lewis at home with her throw to the plate.

The UCLA lead was narrowed to 4-3, but Oregon could come no closer as the Bruins tacked on two runs in the fourth to make it 6-3 and round out the scoring in game one.

Arledge, batting over .400 for
