The Ducks are having one of their best seasons ever under men's head coach Bill Dellinger and women's head coach Tom Heinonen. Both teams are undefeated this year.

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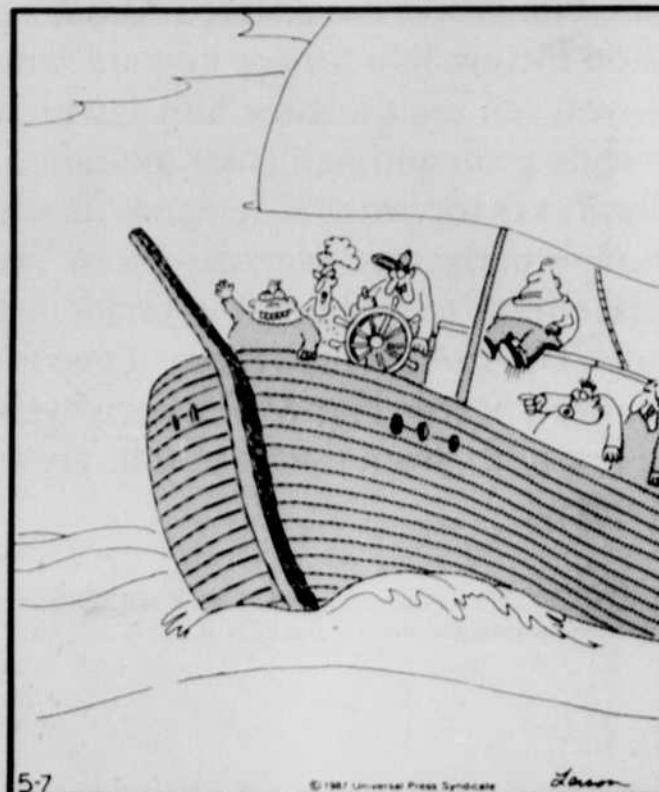
