work session on the bill earlier this session, at which Novick testified, the bill was to exclude all classified research.

Concern was raised during testimony that the wording was too all-encompassing and needed to be more specific.

The bill still allows pro-

prietary, or research conducted by private companies, to be "kept secret until the time of patent," Fawbush said.

The bill also would allow certain types of research currently being conducted at OSU to continue. The research deals with oceanographic and atmospheric

studies. The results of the research still will be published, according to Fawbush, but the "raw data," some of which has been classified by the U.S. Navy, would not be required to be revealed. Specifically, the raw data Fawbush was speaking of consists of maps of the ocean bottom, being made at OSU.
